Data Ownership and Backups

The GRC PAT system is located on an Australian based Cloud, serviced out of Mascot in Sydney. You are free to download any audit at any time so you own the data. We make daily backups for you which are stored for a minimum of 90 days and kept on our secure servers.

While knowing there is a centralised backup gives peace-ofmind, you still retain the ability to make your own local backups so the audit client or auditee have not only the auditor reports, but can retain the data.

If the subscriber wants, and subject to additional annual fees, we can organise for it to be on an Australian Government approved secure cloud server, so their government clients meet their higher and demonstrable data security requirements. GRC PAT can be used by multiple auditors concurrently giving the lead auditor greater flexibility, oversight and control of the audit team whether the team is on-site or not, or working remotely.

GRC PAT can be used by a single auditor to allow his or her processes to be streamlined to make their audits more efficient, saving them time while delivering their clients the reports required and the data generated by each audit if the client wishes. It can be used simply to inspect and tick off observed performance and evidence and still generates graphs and an overview of performance against a proscribed standard.

In larger organisations GRC PAT can be used either for multiple clients needing complex audits or simple inspections and other assurance activities. It can be used to manage both simple and complex audit programs with officers in a larger organisation given various read, write, view and amend permissions. All such permissions related actions reflect an auditable trail of changes to the original closed audit so all levels of management can be held to account for their actions or inaction.
